are reported to induce the expression of this receptor in NK and T cells. This gene along with four other members of the interleukin 1 receptor family; including IL1R2; IL1R1; ILRL2 (IL-1Rr2); and IL1RL1 (T1:ST2); form a gene cluster on the content of the second strength of the second strength in the second strength in

chromosome 2g. Alternatively spliced transcript variants encoding different isoforms have been

found for this gene.
